

The 2010 statistics card presents only a small part of the range of statistics available for the Tees Valley. Much, much more information is available through the TVU website at www.teesvalleyunlimited.gov.uk. This log-on takes you to the TVU home page and from there simply click onto the 'Information & Forecasting' section to gain free and easy access to a wide range of information about the sub-region, its districts, its wards, towns and villages, and other neighbourhood areas.

The number of indicators available for areas has been increased to reflect the demand for more detailed information. For example, for wards in the sub-region there are over 200 indicators covering a variety of topics. A significant number of these indicators are also available for other geographical areas. The indicators are grouped by, and cover a variety of, topics.

Users can also map and compare data sets using InstantAtlas software. This interactive software allows mapping, the ability to display area name and variable values. It is possible to select the data to be mapped and to create pie charts, bar charts and display time series charts which show the change in indicator values over time. Further it is possible to highlight an individual area in the table and see where it is on the map and find its ranking on the bar chart.

The user can print the maps and tables and it is also possible to enlarge the map, zoom in and out, rank areas and to download the data and maps/graphs. The maps can show background (Ordnance Survey) maps, the user can change the map scaling bands, graph area information values over a number of years - very useful for monitoring performance.

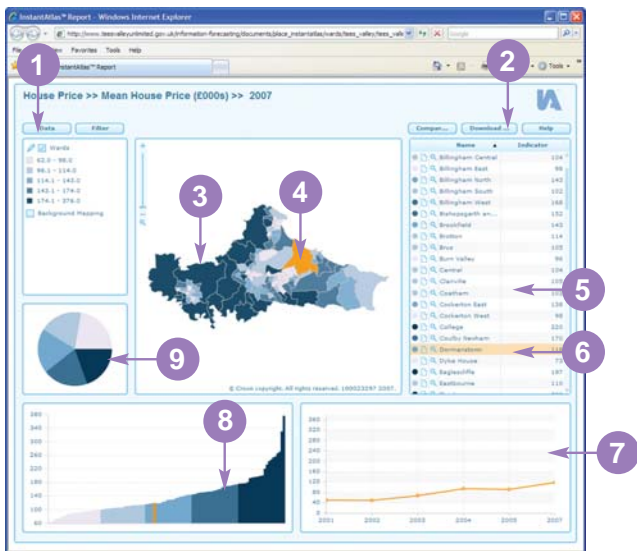
Tees Valley Unlimited
